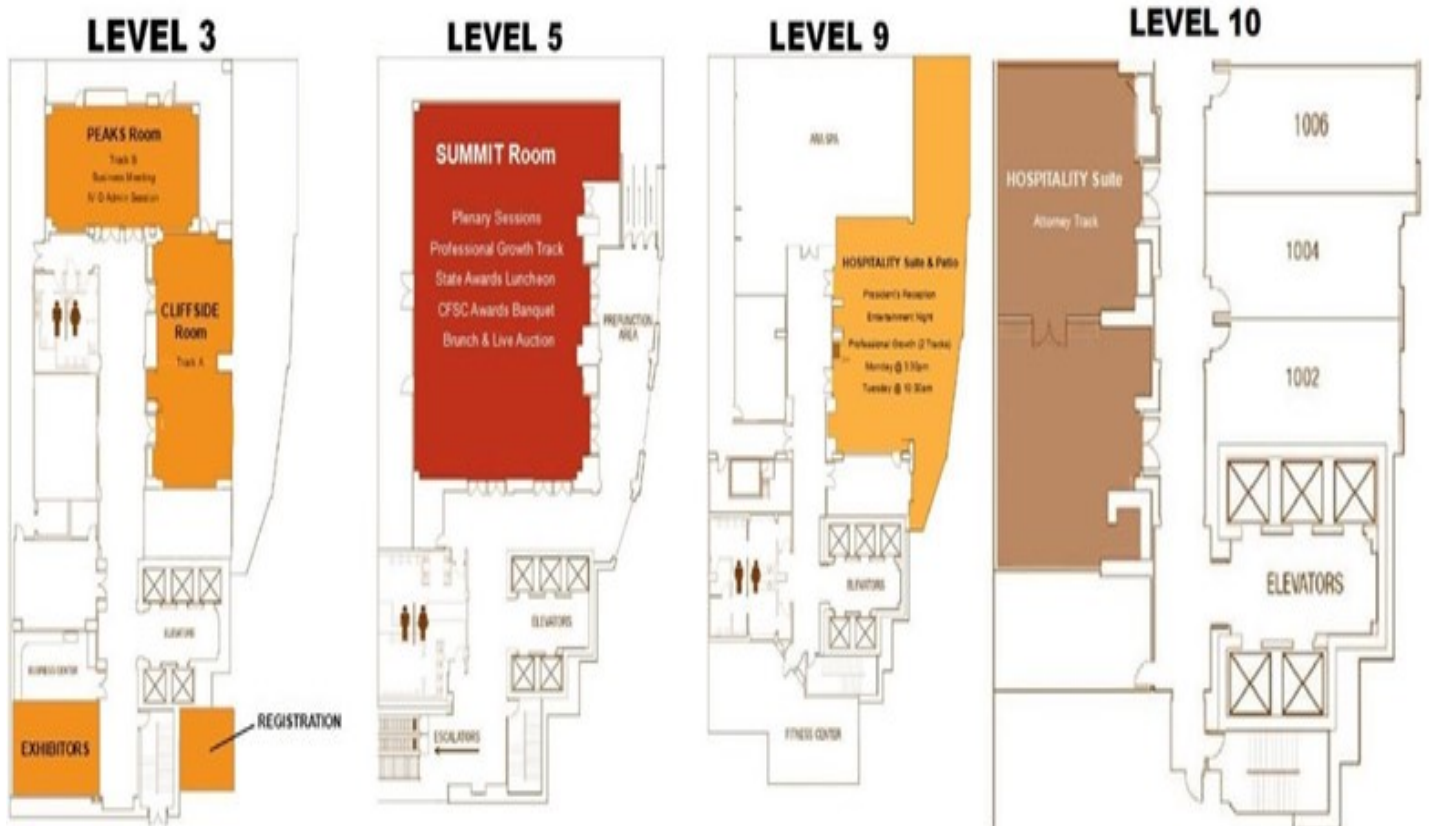

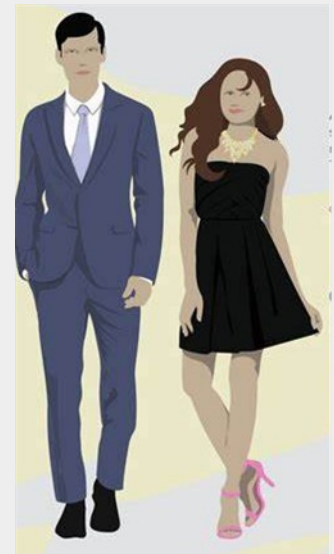

Every year the CFSC Board is looks for new members! If you are interested becoming a board member and wondering what being a board member consist of, here's a brief overview:

Membership: The CFSC Board consist of 13 Officers, 12 Members at Large, Past Presidents, and Honorary Members. Members plan and organize the CFSC Annual Conference, a three-day training event for Colorado Child Support Professionals.

Meetings Attendance: The board meets the first Friday of the month, both virtually and in person, at varying locations. The meetings normally run from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Board members expenses such as lunches, mileage and lodging are not covered by the CFSC Board. Members are expected to attend the meetings either virtually or in person and missing three consecutive meetings could result in removal from the board.

Participation: Board members are expected to serve on at least two committees including sharing ideas, suggestions, and input of the duties specific to the committee, corresponding via emails and phone calls and assisting with the overall production of the Conference.
